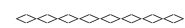

REGENT'S MESSAGE

Everyone's busy during this joyous month of Christmas, but I hope you'll join us for our annual Christmas party; it'll be on our regular meeting night, Monday, December 18th, at 6:30 p.m. in the Mikeska Fellowship Hall (no regular meeting until January). This party is joint with the KCs, and the men will again prepare the meat; please bring a side dish or dessert. Lillian Hansen will hold her annual raffle; please see her note about bringing items. Also, Cindy Riha will have a box to collect items for Casa Juan Diego in Houston; they need adult and children caps, gloves, sweaters, and coats in all sizes, and also blankets.

You've probably already noticed the enclosed envelope and yellow note when you opened this bulletin. As the note states, the envelope is for your dues remittance and also for any donation to the Bakeless Bake Sale. Dues are always due January 1st, and since we're also holding the Bakeless Bake Sale fundraiser beginning January 1st this year, we thought it'd be handy to send out a notice for both. Please be prompt with your dues payment; remember, only \$5.74 of your \$25.00 dues stays with our local court; the remaining \$19.26 has to be sent to national and state offices. We are billed for every member, regardless if you've paid your dues or not. Please help us by sending in your dues!

Scholarships! The state CDA court sponsors an annual Memorial Scholarship; last school year, \$41,750 was awarded to 41 graduating high school seniors across Texas; scholarships ranged from \$500 to \$2,500. If you know of any graduating senior who lives anywhere in Texas and would like to apply, please call me for an application. To be eligible for application, the student must be related to a CDA member, but she can be his/her mother, aunt, or grandmother. Completed applications must be postmarked by January 31, 2018.

Our local court \$300 scholarship is open to any member's child who is a graduating senior, who plans to attend college, and it isn't due until April, but if you are the mother of the student, you must have your annual \$25.00 dues paid by January 31, 2018 for your son/daughter to be eligible. Also, you must have been a member of our court for the preceding two years, which means since January 1, 2016. This scholarship is limited to children of our members as opposed to the state scholarship, which is open to grandchildren, nephews, nieces, etc.

We hope to see you all at the Christmas party; be sure to have a wonderful, safe, and memorable Christmas this year as we welcome the birth of our Savior, and afterwards, the happiest of New Years!

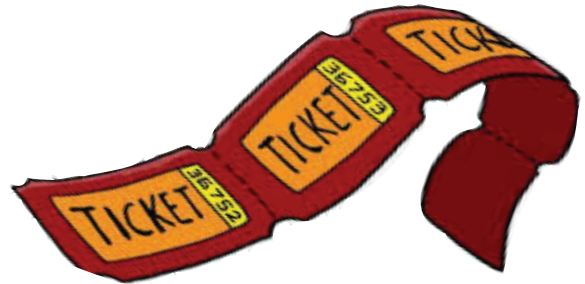

CDA Scholarships for 2018 High School Graduates



State Level Scholarship:

The Texas State Catholic Daughter Court will award at least one (1) \$1,000.00 scholarship and may award additional scholarships if funds are available. In April 2017, 41 Texas students received a total of \$41,750.00 in state CDA scholarships! Those eligible to apply for scholarships are graduating seniors in accredited high schools who are related to living CDA members in good standing.

Applications will be judged on School activities (25%), Church activities (25%), and Essay (50%). The essay subject: How will your faith help you accomplish your goals?

Applications are available at the ECHS Guidance Office. Completed scholarship applications must be postmarked no later than **January 31, 2018**.



Local Level Scholarship:

*Attention, members who have a
graduating high school senior!*

Is your child planing to attend college or technical school? Would he/she like to apply for our local court's \$300 scholarship?

For your child to be eligible, you must have your 2018 dues paid by January 31, 2018 and you must have been a member of our court since January 2016.

The scholarship isn't due until **April 9th**, but dues *must* be paid by January 31st!
