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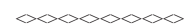

STANDING RULES (Revised February 2017)

1. Scholarships will be awarded annually to children of Court #1374 members who are paid up and have been members for at least two consecutive years. Member's dues must be paid by January 31 of the year in which the student applies for the scholarship. No more than ten (10) scholarships of \$300.00 each will be given. The scholarships will be awarded to eligible applicants when proof of enrollment in a college/technical school is presented. (See Scholarship Application for details.)

2. The Court will host a reception annually for graduating seniors, their parents and school officials.

3. The Court will host birthday parties at Garden Villa by providing refreshments for residents and gifts for the birthday honorees. These parties are to be held several times a year depending upon requests from Garden Villa managers.

4. A Crucifix will be presented to a member when she marries.

5. Get well cards are sent to members who are ill. Sympathy cards are sent to members upon the death of a husband, child, father, mother, sister, brother, sister-in-law, brother-in-law, or grandchild. Congratulations are sent to members on the birth of a child, also on 50th, 55th, 60th, 65th, etc. wedding anniversaries; and birthday cards will be sent to members age 75 and over. Cards of encouragement will be sent to the seriously ill.

6. Funeral lunches served (see attached page for guidelines). In the event of an out-of-town funeral of a member or member's spouse when the lunch is not served by the court, the court will present a check to the family in the amount of \$75.00.

7. Bibles will be given in September of each year to all 4th grade students at St. Philip's School and CCE classes and at St. John's CCD class.

8. \$1,000.00 will be given in February of each year to the St. Philip's School General Fund.

9. The court will have a Christmas Party at the December meeting for members and their guests. The Christmas Party committee will determine details.

10. The court will give monetary gifts at the Clergy Appreciation celebration in the amount of \$100.00 to our court chaplain; \$50.00 to each priest and \$25.00 to each deacon who serve the El Campo and Taiton parishes. Seminarians will be honored with a Memorial Mass card at the beginning of each calendar year.

11. The court will host an "Over Sixties" party the first Sunday in December for members and non-members.

12. The court will have an annual fundraiser to cover general fund expenses and charitable contributions.

13. The convention fund will maintain a minimum balance of

\$4,000.00 and in the event it falls below the minimum balance, we will sponsor a fundraiser. If there is any overage, the overage will be transferred to the general fund. Each delegate to the state convention will receive the convention package paid by the court plus \$300.00, as funds are available. Each delegate to the national convention will receive the convention package paid by the court plus \$500.00, as funds are available. To receive the funds, each delegate must attend the total convention and then be reimbursed at the return home of the convention.

14. Any request or motion for disbursement of funds, other than state or national dues, in excess of \$500.00 will be tabled for publication in the next monthly bulletin so that all members are notified in writing of the amount and purpose of the expenditure. Action will be taken at the meeting following publication.

15. Officers' dues will be reimbursed by the court at the end of their 2-year term.

16. The Financial Secretary and Treasurer will receive an annual \$100 stipend payable by May 31st.

17. A Memorial Mass will be celebrated in November of each year in memory of all deceased members.

STANDING RULES CONCERNING FUNERALS

1. Upon the death of a member, her husband, or a person of her immediate family living in her home such as a child or parent, the Court will furnish a sandwich lunch, or help serve a catered meal and furnish desserts and coffee. If a member predeceases her husband, upon his death, he will be afforded the same courtesies given to his wife.

2. The Regent should be notified of the funeral arrangements as soon as they are finalized.

3. A representative of Court #1374 will be present at the wake and rosary service to assist the priest or deacon in leading the rosary. The CDA Resolution of Condolence will be read at the service and then presented to the family.

4. The CDA banner or plaque will be displayed at the wake service of a deceased member.

5. The meal following the funeral will be served at the Fellowship Hall if available; otherwise the family of the deceased will be required to make arrangements for some other hall or facilities.

6. Upon the death of a member, the court will make a \$55.00 memorial donation in honor of the deceased member. The donation will be sent to one of the following funds, which will be chosen by the deceased member's family:

- A. Mass intentions at the parish of the family's choice
- B. CDA Seminary Burse
- C. State CDA Memorial Scholarship Fund
- D. St. Philip's School Endowment Fund
- E. St. John's Altar Society Memorial Fund
- F. Court #1374 Scholarship Fund

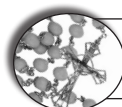
